## ! Information

### An illness grant converts part of your loan to a grant

The maximum period for which your loan can be converted to a grant is four months and two weeks per academic year. Lånekassen can only convert your loan to a grant for periods of illness that start after we have received a loan application from you.

### In order to convert your loan to a grant you must

- have been healthy when the course started (Lånekassen can grant a dispensation if your course lasts for several years)
- document the period you were ill or your child was ill (from date to date)
- have been completely incapable of studying due to your own illness or completely prevented from studying due to the illness of your child

### When you are ill or your child is ill

If you are completely incapable of studying for more than two consecutive weeks of the academic year because you are ill, you can have your loan for this period converted to a grant. The same applies if you are completely prevented from studying because your child under 12 years old is ill. This also applies for children who turn 12 in the calendar year for which you are applying for an illness grant.

### Ineligibility due to receipt of benefits from Nav

Your loan cannot be converted to a grant, if you received sickness benefit or unemployment benefit from the National Insurance Scheme during the entire period of illness. Lånekassen may consider converting your loan into a grant for that part of the period during which you did not receive benefits from Nav, if you received benefits for only part of the period of illness.

### Documentation

#### Own illness

Your doctor, or someone else entitled to issue sick leave certificates, must confirm in section 3 the period of illness stipulated in section 2. Or you can enclose a sick leave certificate confirming the dates of the period of illness and that you were completely incapable of studying.

#### If your child under 12 years old is ill

The doctor must confirm in sections 2 and 3 the period during which you were completely prevented from studying due to the child's illness. Or you can enclose a sick leave certificate confirming the dates of the period.

### Application deadline

The application must be received by Lånekassen no later than six months after the academic year/course has ended.
